IMPORTANT LIMITATIONS AND CAVEATS

- Data are not available for all groups due to population size and opportunities to self-identify in surveys
- Many Native Americans identify as Native American plus another race on Census surveys, which results in Native American undercounts
- Only gender categories in most of our data are male and female
- We understand that encountering this data can be difficult
- We are mindful of critiques about how current data norms, language, and practices can be harmful









LIFE EXPECTANCY AT BIRTH BY GENDER AND RACE AND ETHNICITY








EDUCATION INDEX BY GENDER AND BY RACE & ETHNICITY








LIFE EXPECTANCY BY CENSUS TRACT

LIFE EXPECTANCY AT BIRTH BY GENDER AND RACE AND ETHNICITY





EDUCATION INDEX BY GENDER AND BY RACE & ETHNICITY






EARNINGS BY CENSUS TRACT
